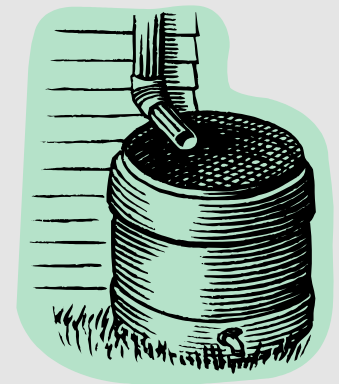

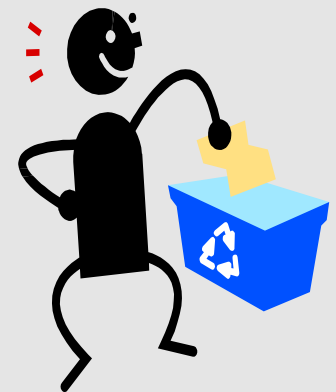
RAIN BARREL WORKSHOP AT ROSWELL GREEN EXPO

In addition to all of the vendors, seminars, and entertainment at the Roswell Green Expo on February 23, we will also be offering a FREE make and take rain barrel workshop at 1:30pm! Only 15 slots are available, so you must pre-register! Online registration will open on January 22 at www.keeptoswellbeautiful.org. Participants should be prepared to make your own rain barrel out of Coca-Cola syrup drums. Vans or SUVs work best for transporting your barrel home. Please, Roswell residents only and only one barrel per household.



RECYCLING TIP

Roswell residents, when bringing your two copy paper-sized boxes of documents (per person, per day) for shredding between 1:00 - 4:00 pm Monday through Friday, please remove all metal items larger than a staple as well as rubber bands, file folders, booklets, etc. A little preparation will make the shredding process much quicker and reduce your wait time.

2nd Annual Roswell Green Expo

Returns February 23

Roswell's Sustainability Committee and Keep Roswell Beautiful are pleased to announce the 2013 Roswell Green Expo is scheduled for Saturday, February 23 at Hembree Park from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. In its second year, the expo's mission is to educate residents about "green" practices they can incorporate into their lives and homes.

Children's activities include a special music performance "Boogie Woogie Bullfrog" by local artist Jerry Zee and the opportunity to mix and mingle with costumed characters, including Captain Planet, "BAIR" from the Clean Air Campaign, "Bag Monster" from the One More Generation, and "KiRBy" from Keep Roswell Beautiful.

Guests will also enjoy educational sessions, a "trashion" fashion show presented by local student groups, and a "Green Market" full of exciting vendors. Featured speakers and sessions include Dr. Ken Hughes from Skolex Bio-Technologies, Nikki Belmonte from the Atlanta Audubon Society, and a rain barrel workshop by Vicki Culbreth, Environmental Education Coordinator for the City of Roswell.

"The expo is a great way for residents to learn about being green while having fun," said Janet Liberman, co-chair of the Roswell Green Expo and Executive Director of Keep Roswell Beautiful. "The workshops, entertainment and vendors are designed to actively engage community members while teaching simple ways to be sustainable and green. It is not to be missed."

Rules and guidelines

1. Any student group, grades K-12, located within the city of Roswell is eligible to participate (classrooms, school clubs, scout groups, etc).
2. There is no limit to how many outfits each group can create.
3. Acceptable materials include any type of reused or recycled items, such as paper, plastic, tin, etc., which otherwise would have gone in the trash or recycling bin.
4. Fabric may ONLY be used as a base on which to attach your recycled items.
5. Attachment materials, such as staples, glue, string, etc. are permitted.
6. Decorative materials, such as paint, marker, glitter, sewing notions, etc are NOT permitted.
7. Each outfit must be modeled by a student on the runway during the Trashion Show.

Judging

For fun, all outfits will be judged by Green Expo staff and volunteers. Categories for judging are: **Most Creative, Best Construction, and Most Chic.**
